**Dom Perignon, France (1999)** 180.60  
 Dom Perignon (1638-1715) was a monk and cellar master at the Benedictine Abbey in Hautvillers. He was the first to blend grapes in such a way as to improve the quality of the wines and deal with a number of their imperfections, in 1670. He also introduced corks, which were fastened to bottles with hemp string soaked in oil in order to keep the wines fresh and sparkling, and used thicker glass in order to strengthen the bottles (which were prone to explosion). The development of sparkling wines as the main style of production in Champagne occurred progressively in the 19<sup>th</sup> Century, over one century after Dom Perignon's death.
